

Peter Švík received an MA (2006) in political science and a Ph.D. (2012) in international history from the Comenius University in Bratislava and from Institute of History, Slovak Academy of Sciences in Bratislava, respectively. He was a visiting fellow at British Academy, London, École normale supérieure, Paris, Leibniz-Institut für Europäische Geschichte, Mainz and at the Vienna and Leipzig universities. From October 2012 to September 2013, he was a Guggenheim fellow at the Smithsonian National Air and Space Museum in Washington. From August 2012 to July 2015, he was working as an ERMOS 98 post-doctoral fellow at the University of Tartu, Estonia. From October 2015 to September 2016 he was a Gerda Henkel fellow at the Historisches Kolleg – Institute for Advanced Study in Munich. Since August 2017 he is a Lise Meitner fellow at the Institute for Eastern European History of the University of Vienna where the project has been shifted from the Institute from Modern and Contemporary History of the Austrian Academy of Sciences. He authored several peer-reviewed studies and one monograph on European integration in Slovak. Currently, he is preparing an English written monograph on East-West civil aviation policies during the Cold War.
